## What to Bring

- Bible and notebook
- Pillows, sleeping bags, bedding
- Toiletries, towels
- Flashlights and Bug spray
- Bathing suits and towels, in case it is hot and dry
- Warm clothing, in case it is cold and wet
- Extra shoes

**Medical Concerns** There is a licensed nurse and a well equipped medical facility on the campgrounds to handle minor medical issues. There are local hospitals in the area. Please do not come to camp with any contagious illness.

**Spending Money / Camper Fees** Campers may make purchases at the camp store. Items available include snacks, souvenirs, clothing, books and more. Fees can be paid in installments on-line. It is appreciated if the balance is paid in full before coming to camp, but the balance will be due upon arrival.
